Year 1 Phonics Screening Check

Attainment at KS1 (2016)

KS2 SATs Results (2016)

The 2016 Key Stage 2 assessments are the first which assess the new, more challenging National Curriculum. New tests and interim frameworks have been introduced to reflect the revised curriculum. Results are no longer reported using levels and instead each pupil will now receive their results as a scaled score and their teacher assessments as one of a number of categories.

The scaled score range runs from 80 to 120 with 100 as the expected standard.
