Good morning everyone! I hope you are all well, happy and healthy! This week I would like you to focus on the story *Into the Forest* by Anthony Browne, which the children are familiar with. The story is a modern take on traditional fairy tales and features a lot of references and images. Children need to listen to the story, look at the pictures on Google and identify the references. Children could then rewrite the ending in a traditional sense or do the same for the beginning, starting with 'once upon a time...'

Other ideas are to imagine they are the main character and write a diary entry, or write a new section of the book where the boy meets a new character such as Rumpelstiltskin or the 3 bears.

I'm maths this week look at addition of two 2-digit numbers. Start off with numbers that don't have a crossover (known as regrouping) such as $24 + 32$. Children know how to stack the numbers, and can also regroup. Remember to always add the ones first, then the tens. If there is a crossover, the tens number goes below the equal sign, such as $38 + 15$. Numbers with a 0 are sometimes tricky so save these until last.

For topic this week I would like children to do a little geography. Pick a country and find as many facts as possible. Some facts to research would be the continent, capital, language, main religion...
